# **Up-date from the Steering Committee: June 16, 2019**



Since the last up-date from the Steering Committee, we are pleased to report that the following has taken place:

- ✓ 5 people have signed up for Givings by Automatic Withdrawal. The target is 2 additional registrations for Givings by Automatic Withdrawal per month.
- ✓ There has been a slight increase in weekly givings to the current account. We sincerely thank you for your generosity.
- ✓ The debt to the city of \$11,288 has been eliminated.
- ✓ To date, \$10,000 has been transferred from the HTF for operating expenses.
- ✓ The fire panel will be completed very shortly.
- ✓ The outstanding debt on the roof as of the end of May is \$13,817.67, down from the \$18,067.07 that was reported in January.

The continuing target is to increase the number of people who register for Givings by Automatic Withdrawal. Last week the forms were included in the bulletin. If you are interested in this program or have questions, Karen Blanchard will be in the MacLellan Room following the service today.
